

Citizens are being motivated to come forward to present their ideas. The selected citizens then receive 15 to 20 days of mentorship, including training on how to present their ideas effectively. As Deputy Commissioner Patiala, she successfully implemented this idea. Her relentless working during 2023 floods in Patiala establishes her exceptional identity.

We have given opportunities to all our students so that they realize their true potential and get ready to face the professional world once they complete their studies.



Equipped with 7 computers (6 terminals and 1 server), connected with LAN networking, having Alice for Windows Version 6.00, Library Automated software. Issue and Return is done with Bar Code Scanner. The Library has internet facility for the staff.

• KIOSK

Efficient and quick information of the availability of Library books has been provided to its readers. The availability of Digital kiosk to provide self-accessed enquiry (OPAC) is a unique feature of the College Library.

• E-RESOURCES

E-Resources are the need of 21^{st} century and to cater this need, the Library ensures access to E-resources through NLIST, a programme of the INFLIBNET (Information and Library Network), Ahmedabad, to its readers. The readers can access 1,95,809 e-books and 6792 e-journals through NLIST. They can get the username and password from the library office and access it from anywhere and at anytime. **355** e-resources have been viewed by the various readers through NLIST. Moreover, *ePG-Pathshala* and *eShodhganga* are the salient features of NLIST for the researchers to get the theses for their research.

• STAR READER OF THE LIBRARY

The College Library selects its most regular students of the Library as **STAR READER OF THE LIBRARY** every month to motivate them to develop their books reading habits. This is the first time that not only boys and even girls are also participating in the above and becoming the star reader.

• READER'S CLUB

A Reader's Club has been generated by the members of teaching staff of various faculties to motivate maximum students to widely use the Library resources and also explore e-resources through NLIST. A new exercise, i.e.

A very useful corner has been set up for the benefit of the students and also to judge their honesty. To use this section, students need not to go and ask for the book to the Library Officials. They can take the books from the almirahs of the above corner for reading and keep on its respective place after the reading at their own. The students enter their entry along with book number in the respective register and sign.
