










### Minutes of the Meeting held on May 29, 2025:


The meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was convened on May 29, 2025, under the esteemed chairmanship of Principal Dr. Amardeep Gupta. The session commenced with a cordial welcome extended to all members, followed by deliberations on the agenda items pertaining to academic enhancement, infrastructural development, innovation, and student welfare.

- The house deliberated on potential avenues for financial generation to support institutional development activities. A proposal to install a 10 kW solar power plant was approved, reinforcing the institution's commitment to sustainable and eco-friendly energy practices.
- The Alumni Association assured continued sponsorship of fee of needy students from economically weaker sections, reflecting their enduring bond with their alma mater.
- The committee deliberated on the adoption of advanced Learning Management System (LMS) platforms, in addition to Google Classroom and Google Drive, to further streamline and enhance the teaching-learning processes. It was resolved that the LMS club will explore viable options and present a comparative report in the forthcoming IQAC meeting.
- The Cell proposed to conduct Green Audit, Energy Audit, and Environment Audit during the current semester to evaluate and enhance environmental performance.
- Departments should be encouraged to collaborate with external agencies to commemorate International Biodiversity Day, National Science Day, and World Environment Day through seminars, exhibitions, and plantation drives.
- All departments were commended for conducting Remedial Classes for slow learners and were encouraged to continue the initiative regularly.
- Bridge Courses were proposed for newly admitted students to strengthen foundational understanding in various disciplines: Commerce Stream – Basics of Accounting and Business Concepts, BCA/B.Sc (IT) – Fundamentals of Mathematics and Computer Applications, Computer Information Systems – Digital and Computational Foundations
- These bridge courses shall be provided free of cost. Additionally, departments were advised to design short-term paid certificate courses aimed at enhancing employability and skill acquisition.
- Faculty members were encouraged to seek external research funding and establish Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) with industries to foster experiential and collaborative learning opportunities. The members appreciated the efforts of various department signing 20 MoU's with Industry/Institution. The chairman appreciated the effort of the following departments for applying and getting sanction grant for conducting FDP/Seminar/Workshop in the coming session. Grants sanctioned for various departments were noted as follows:
  - Department of Hindi – ₹1.00 lakh (ICSSR) (Seminar on IKS/NEP. Sanction on May 01, 2025).
  - Department of History – ₹1.15 lakh (ICSSR) (National Seminar. Sanction on April 29, 2025).
  - IIC- ₹3.5 lakhs was (MHRD) (FDP. Sanction on May 21, 2025).
- It was resolved that a Faculty Development Program (FDP) will be organized during the last week of July 2025 focusing on innovative pedagogical practices and research enhancement.
  - The Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) proposed organizing a Buildthon in August 2025, coordinated by the Department of Computer Science Department
  - Business Ideathon and Innovation Challenges will be launched to cultivate entrepreneurial and problem-solving aptitude among students.
  - Outreach programmes for school students will be jointly conducted by the Science and Commerce departments to stimulate scientific curiosity and innovation.


- IQAC Proposed to Workshops in the coming semester
  - Practical Skills Workshop for school students by the Science Department ( Vigyan Mahotsava 2025).
  - Teacher Training and Pedagogical Workshop as an extension activity
- The Alumni Association was encouraged to intensify mentoring programmes for final-year students to strengthen career guidance and professional networking.
- A CSR Activity, in collaboration with Mahindra & Mahindra, was proposed for the empowerment and skill development of girl students. It was proposed that other Organizations/Agencies should be approached for search type of activities .
- A Strategic Plan Brochure (SP) along with Institution Development Plan (IDP) outlining the institution's goals and initiatives will be released.
- MSME registration will be pursued to facilitate innovation and start-up ventures under institutional initiatives.
- More frequent industrial visits and internship opportunities will be organized to bridge the gap between academia and industry.

The meeting concluded with a formal vote of thanks to the Chair. All members expressed their commitment to implementing the discussed initiatives in the forthcoming academic session.
