Serving others, selflessly, is always a challenging task. And here is a distinguished medical professional who has been serving this Holy City and the Nation for over thirty years.



His outstanding administrative and managerial skills are evident from his appointment as the President of Chief Khalsa Diwan, Amritsar, a branch of Indian Medical Association and as the President of Indian Radiology and Imaging Association for 2013-2014.

Hon'ble Dr. Nijjar has been actively contributing for the healthy environment of Amritsar. He has been passionately donating trees for over 20 years. He got a 4-acre park cleared of rubble in Ranjit Avenue and got more than 3000 trees and shrubs planted, some of them were from his own nursery.


FOOTBALL (WOMEN)
