In the meanwhile, the Aam Aadmi Party made him the President of Ex-MulajamWing. S. Harbhajan Singh was fielded as a candidate from Jandiala Guru Constituency, but after losing the election, he did not give up his courage and continued to work hard. After that, continuing his journey forward, he obtained a law degree and in 2022 assembly elections, Mr. Singh fielded from Jandiala Guru Constituency and won with a huge margin of about 26000 votes and became a member of the 16th Punjab Vidhan Sabha and took oath as Minister of Power and Public Works Department in the Punjab Government.

Inspired by Bharat Ratna Babasaheb Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar, Mr. Singh is still continuing his studies and is doing Ph.D in Political Science from Panjab University, Chandigarh. 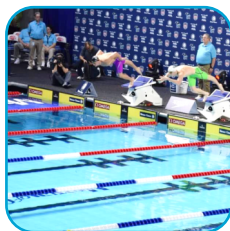
Team Performance at a Glance

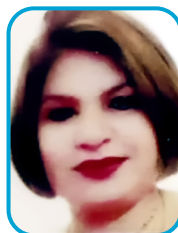

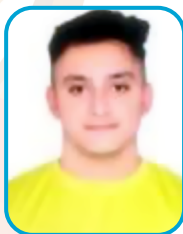
